
David Ortiz: An American Icon



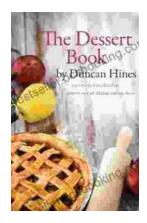
