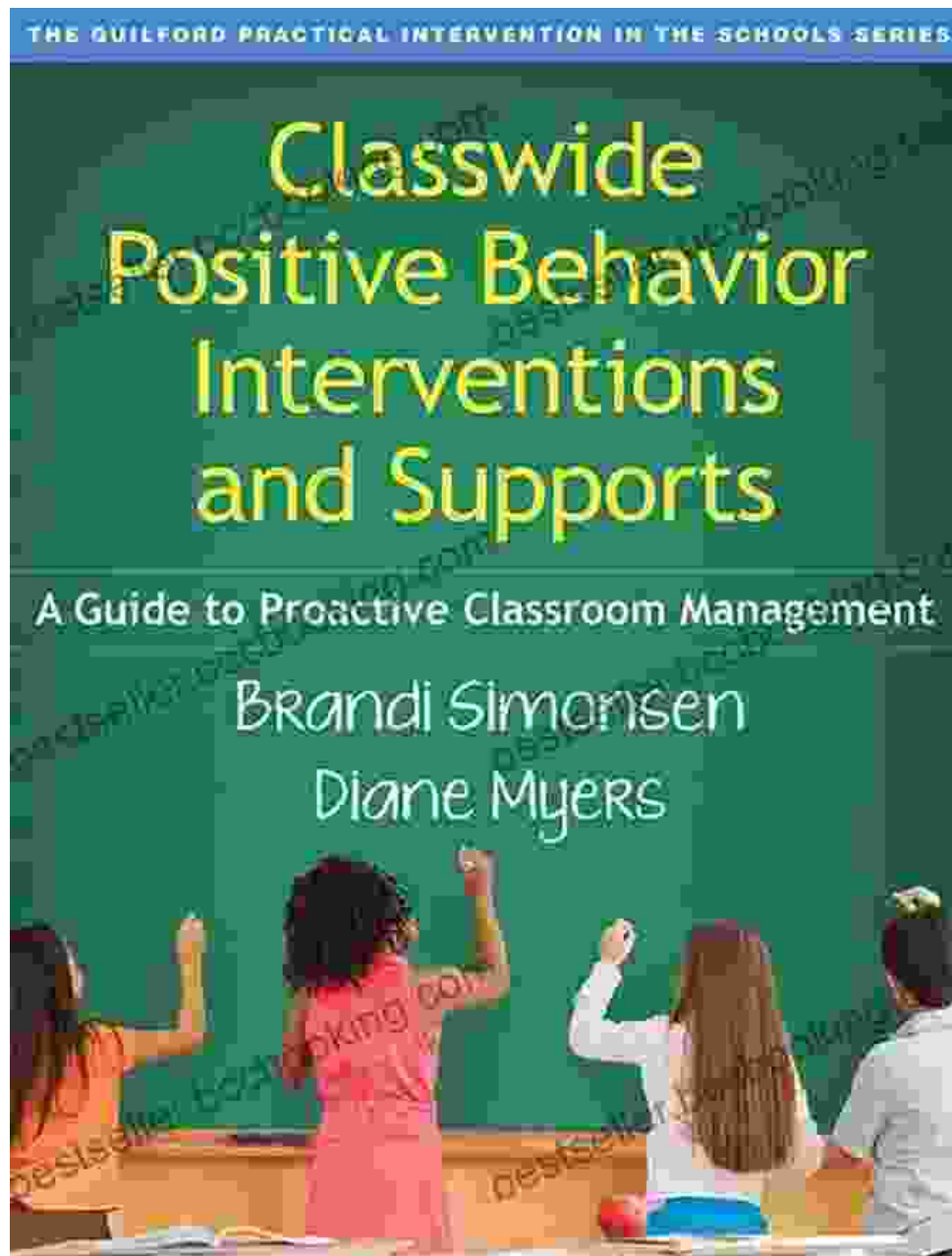

- **5 to 1 ratio of positive to negative interactions**

- Reprimands or corrective statements work better in the context of a positive, reinforcing environment

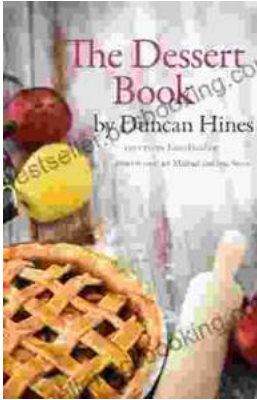
