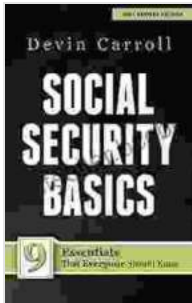
Benefits for Spouses and Children

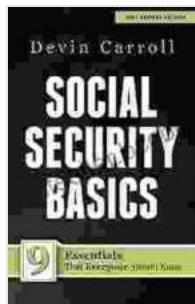

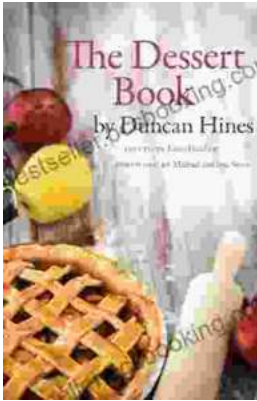
